



CHSE JROTC Cadet Distance Learning (DL) Registration Instructions

Over the course of the school year, as a Cranston East Junior ROTC Cadet you will be completing a number of lessons using the Cadet Command Distance Learning website. The purpose is two fold: first, it will introduce you to taking classes via the internet as many college and universities now offer such opportunities. Secondly, the selected lessons will augment those lessons received in the Cranston East JROTC classroom.

The JROTC Cadet Distance Learning (DL) website is located at www.JROTCDL.com

Before taking the lessons you are required to register with the website. Proceed to the above website and click the **Register button**. This will open the Self Registration window.

As a JROTC Cadet you should use your own email address as you Log-in name. Within the "Are you a JROTC Cadet" box click yes.

From the drop down menu, select the JROTC program you are participating in "**Army Cranston High School East**".

Once complete, click the "**Submit your Registration**". You will be exited back to the login screen.

After you have registered, you will receive an email with a temporary password you can use to log into the Distance Learning website.

NOTE: Upon first log in, the system will prompt you to change your password. **You need to keep track of the password that you create for yourself.** If you do lose the password, you can click the E-mail Your Password? Button located on the home page of the site and the system will email the Cadet their current password.

After logging into the site, it will take you to the **Recommended Training Tab** which has the list of courses that are available. Each course is comprised of lessons and a course final exam.

Upon completing the End of Course Evaluation, print the course certificate and present it to your JROTC instructor for grading in ASPEN. Once graded, file the certificate in **Tab 9** of your Cadet Portfolio in Rm 313. Each Course is worth one (1) test grade towards your quarter grade.
